At our June 29<sup>th</sup> meeting the Committee voted unanimously to strongly recommend to the Planning Board and Council the following:

- 1. that the Planning Board and Council oppose Ordinance 16-2017 that would allow the joining of two lots 26 and 27 on Block 4102 for the purpose of constructing a self-storage facility on Route 4
- 2. that the township purchases the Seigel & Seigel property for inclusion in the Greenbelt
- 3. that Council complete the process begun in 1987 by Resolution 118-87 introduced by then Councilman Lou Schwartz, authorizing the submission of application forms to New Jersey and National Register of Historical Places for the entire Greenbelt which the State and County have declared eligible and meeting the criteria for Historic landmark status, to in fact apply for historic status for the entire Greenbelt.

The goal of the committee in preserving Teaneck's Greenbelt is to protect and maintain the quality of life of all residents of Teaneck, to be the guardian of the natural environment that is the Greenbelt, and to maintain and improve property values of the homes along Route 4.
